- You will need a **simple** calculator capable of performing basic arithmetic operations, including square roots. You may **not** use your cell phone, computer, or pda for this purpose. Do **NOT** bring a programmable calculator or one with built in statistical functions.

You may *NOT* borrow a calculator, and proctors will not give out loaners. It is your responsibility to check that your **batteries** are functioning.

Simple calculators are still available for about \$4.00 now (they are cheaper at the start of the semester) at stores like Staples, Walmart, and the campus bookstore. You need something that looks like these:

- You will be expected to use the **tables** (which will be provided) for computations involving the normal curve, and you will be expected to compute other values (mean, median, percentiles) directly – not using a programmed calculator function. Using a programmed calculator function may result in an answer different and be marked wrong.
- You may not use a laptop or pad computer, cell phone, pda, or other electronic device. If you bring any such device to class, it must be powered off and stowed away out of sight.
- You should not bring anything to the exam room other than your ID card, 3×5 card, elementary calculator, and writing tools. Do not bring your text, notes, or other printed materials.
