- You will need a simple calculater capable of performing basic arithmetic operations, including square roots. You may not use your cell phone, computer, or pda for this purpose. Do NOT bring a programmable calculator or one with built in statistical functions.

You may NOT borrow a calculator, and proctors will not give out loaners. It is your responsibilty to check that your batteries are functioning.

Simple calculators are still available for about $\$ 4.00$ now (they are cheaper at the start of the semester) at stores like Staples, Walmart, and the campus bookstore. You need something that looks like these:
